- 2. How do you respond when you read the warnings of God in his Word? Do you see these warnings as God's grace in your life?
- 3. What promised from God do you hold dear? How do you remind yourself of these promises on a regular basis?
- 4. How do you respond to God's faithfulness. In what ways do you allow your faith in God to result in obedience?

Preparation Questions

- 1. Read Genesis 7:17-24. How does this passage describe the flood? How does it describe the results of the flood?
- 2. How does chapter 8 begin? How do verse 1-8 describe God's remembering of Noah?
- 3. Read Genesis 8:13-19. What did God command Noah to do? How did Noah respond in verses 18-19?
- 4. Read Genesis 8:20-22 and Genesis 9:8-17. How does God describe this covenant he makes with Noah and his descendants? What command does God give to Noah in Genesis 9:1? What changed in man's relationship to the animals in verses 2-5?
